Bala Dharan is Vice President in the finance, accounting and valuation group at CRA Charles River Associates, a litigation and business consulting firm with over 600 consultants in 14 offices in the US and 7 offices abroad. Before joining CRA, he taught accounting and finance at Rice University and at Kellogg School of Management, Northwestern University. He has extensive litigation and business consulting experience and has provided expert testimony on accounting and disclosures, transactions analysis, damages, and valuation. He has been invited three times by the United States Congress to testify on these issues. He is currently working on several litigation matters arising from the credit crisis, including the financial analysis of complex transactions, analysis of derivatives, goodwill valuation, and fair value disclosures. Bala has published widely in major accounting and finance journals. He is a co-author of four books covering financial accounting and finance topics, including *Enron and Other Corporate Fiascos* published in 2009. He is currently a visiting professor of accounting at Harvard Law School and at MIT Sloan School of Management. He has also been a visiting professor at the Harvard Business School and at University of California, Berkeley.
