

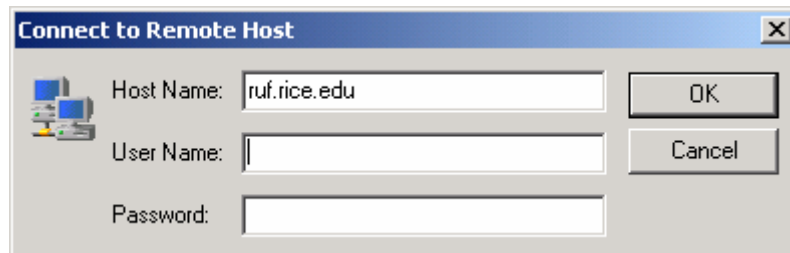
How to Create a Personal Web Page at Rice

You can create a simple personal home page from your Unix account on RUF by creating a file called “public_html/index.html” under your home directory. Everything you place in the “public_html” directory will be visible on the World Wide Web, and your home page will be the “index.html” file.

The first step is to create your public_html directory.

To create the “public_html” directory, log into your RUF account using SSH Secure File Transfer.

1. Start the SSH Secure File Transfer program
2. On the **File** menu, select **Connect...**(or click the computer icon on the toolbar)
3. On the Host Name field, enter **ruf.rice.edu**
4. Enter your user name and password, click OK.



5. On the **Operation** menu, select **New Folder**
6. Enter **public_html** for the folder name

Next, you will need to upload the index.html file and place it inside the public_html directory. You can create your index.html file using Microsoft FrontPage.

To upload the index.html, log into your RUF account (1-4 above)

1. Double-click the public_html directory
2. On the Operation menu, select Upload (or click the upload button on the toolbar)
3. The Upload-Select Files window will appear. Select the index.html file, and click Upload

When you're finished, your page will be visible at the location:
