**ACTION ITEM TITLE:** Coat Rack in CPC or Admissions Office

**BRIEF DESCRIPTION:** It was reported that suits stored in the assigned lockers were often being “crushed” and wrinkled and that there was no place to adequately store them at the present time. It was recommended that a coat rack in the CPC or the Admissions office might be a good solution when a student needs to wear a suit for an interview or presentation but does not want to wear it all day.

**RESOLUTION STEPS:** Individuals in the CPC office were asked what they thought about the possibility of placing a coat rack in the office. They replied that there is in fact a closet in the office that could be used for suit storage if students so desired. The closet is locked at all times and would require a key that they would happily provide to gain access. They also commented that the lockers were chosen because they were specially designed to comfortably hold a man’s suit. Concerns were raised that a coat rack could also be a possible target for theft. *The resolution is to either carefully utilize your locker, place your suit in the locked CPC closet, or possibly simply keep it in your car.* It should be noted that an additional problem with a coat rack centers on the fact that both the Admissions and CPC offices close promptly at 5:00 so after that suits would be inaccessible. Students wishing to place their suit in the CPC closet should also be aware of this.
