

NOTICE OF HEARING

On December 10, 2009, the Copyright Royalty Judges received a motion from RealNetworks, Inc.¹ requesting the issuance of subpoenas *ad testificandum* and *duces tecum* to nonparties Pandora Media, Inc., Slacker, Inc., and CBS Interactive. By motion, Live365, Inc. seeks to join the RealNetworks, Inc. requests.

Oppositions and replies having been filed, the Copyright Royalty Judges shall conduct a hearing on the subpoena requests. The hearing shall be on Tuesday, January 12, 2010, at 10 a.m. in the Copyright Office hearing room, Room LM-408, Library of Congress, James Madison Memorial Building, 101 Independence Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. Parties to this proceeding, as well as representatives of the three nonparties identified in the subpoena requests, may participate.
